This year our observance of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14. Lent is the season when we get our hearts and souls ready to celebrate Jesus dying then rising to save us. It is a time for prayers and reflection about our habits and our lives. There are many opportunities here at St. Andrew's and at the Church of the Assumption to observe this season prayerfully.

Ash Wednesday

At St. Andrew's, Prayer Service with Ashes at 4:30 PM, Mass with Ashes at 7:00 PM
At Church of the Assumption, Mass with Ashes at 8:00 AM and 7:30 PM, Prayer Service with Ashes at 12 noon, and 3:00 PM

Stations of the Cross, and Soup and Stations, beginning Friday, February 16

At St. Andrew's, Stations of the Cross at 10:00 AM. Free Soup Supper at 6:00 PM, followed by Stations at 7:00 PM. This will continue throughout Lent. Soup each Friday is sponsored by various parish groups and committees.

At Church of the Assumption, Stations of the Cross at 7:00 PM. This will continue throughout Lent, and has a different theme each week.

Church of the Assumption also participates in Community Lenten Soup Suppers, with the first being held at the Assumption Hall behind the chapel on Evergreen Road on Monday, February 19, from 4:00 - 7:00 PM. This will always be held on Mondays, but at different locations with different sponsors.

Mass or a **Communion Service** will be celebrated at St. Andrew's at 7:00 PM each Wednesday evening throughout Lent. Mass is celebrated daily at 8:00 AM at the Church of the Assumption Chapel on Evergreen Rd.
